Itinerary

Day 1 Pickup - Drive to Materuni Village



Morning pickup from Moshi (or Arusha on request) and drive to Materuni Village on the lower slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro. Meet your local guide and start the day.

Day 2 Materuni Waterfalls Hike - Nature Walk



Enjoy a guided hike through farms and forest to Materuni Waterfalls. Take time to relax, enjoy the views, and take photos. Swimming is possible depending on conditions.

Day 3

Chagga Coffee Tour - Roast and Taste



Head back to the village for a hands-on coffee tour. Learn the process, roast and grind the beans, then enjoy tasting fresh local coffee.

Day 4

Local Lunch - Return to Moshi

Meals: Lunch



Enjoy a local lunch, then drive back to Moshi. Drop-off in the late afternoon.

Frequently Asked Questions

How difficult is the Materuni Waterfalls hike?

It is a moderate walk. The trail can be muddy after rain, so good shoes are recommended.

Can we swim at the waterfall?

Swimming is sometimes possible, depending on water level and conditions. Your guide will advise on the day.

How long is the coffee tour?

Usually 1 to 2 hours, including roasting, grinding, and tasting.

Is this trip private?

Yes. You will have private transfers and a local guide for the experience.
